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Transaction Overview

Transaction Overview

- On March 17, 2015, The Wall Street Journal announced social media data mining company Dataminr had raised \$130 million in a new round of financing
 - New investors in this round include Fidelity Investments, Wellington Management Co., Credit Suisse, Goldman Sachs, Glynn Capital Management along with individual investors John Mack and Vikram Pandit
 - Previous investors Venrock and Institutional Venture Partners also participated in this round
- The Wall Street Journal claims the deal values the company at about \$700 million
- Before this round, Dataminr had raised \$49.6 million in total VC funding, including a \$30 million Series C round
- Dataminr plans to use this investment to add new sources of data to enhance its Twitter intelligence and develop a new application that leverages its technology for enterprise risk management
- The Wall Street Journal also suggests the fundraising may lay the groundwork for a future IPO
- There has been significant M&A and financing activity among Dataminr's competitors:
 - Gnip was acquired by Twitter in 2014
 - Topsy was acquired by Apple for more than \$200 million in 2013
 - DataSift has raised \$77.9 million in financing
 - Quid just announced a \$39 million financing round
