• On December 14, 2016, BlueVine announced it has raised \$49 million in Series D financing from its existing investors

Participating investors:













- The Company plans to use the funding to expand its team and product offerings
- The Company also announced increases in its maximum credit lines due to client demand, with the following changes:
 - Invoice factoring maximum credit limit increased from \$250,000 to \$2,000,000
 - Business lines of credit maximum credit limit increased from \$50,000 to \$100,000
- BlueVine is on track to fund over \$500 million in working capital in 2017
- The round values the Company at \$124 million (pre-money) according to PitchBook
