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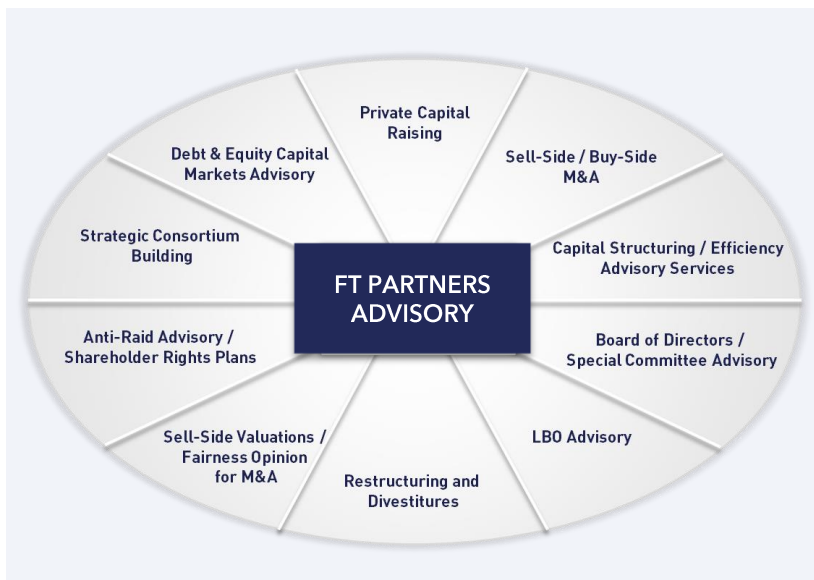

 - The consortium will also earn an equity stake in the company based on the amount of loans purchased, further aligning the group with Prosper's future growth and success

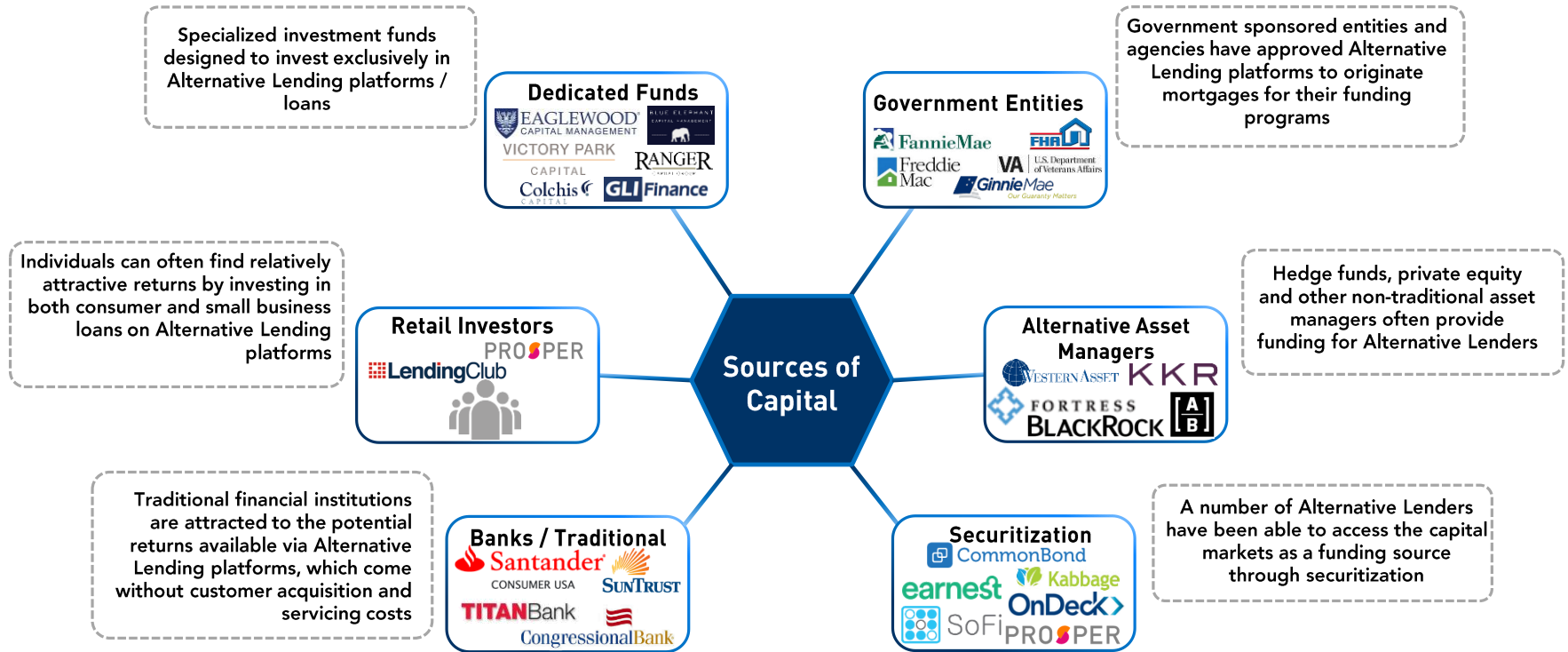

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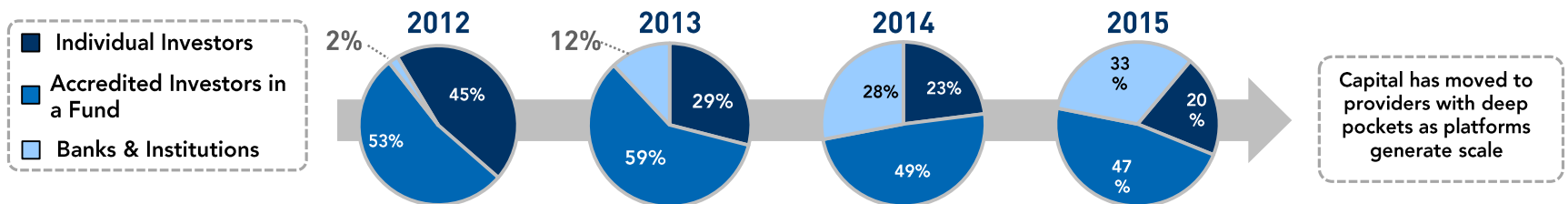

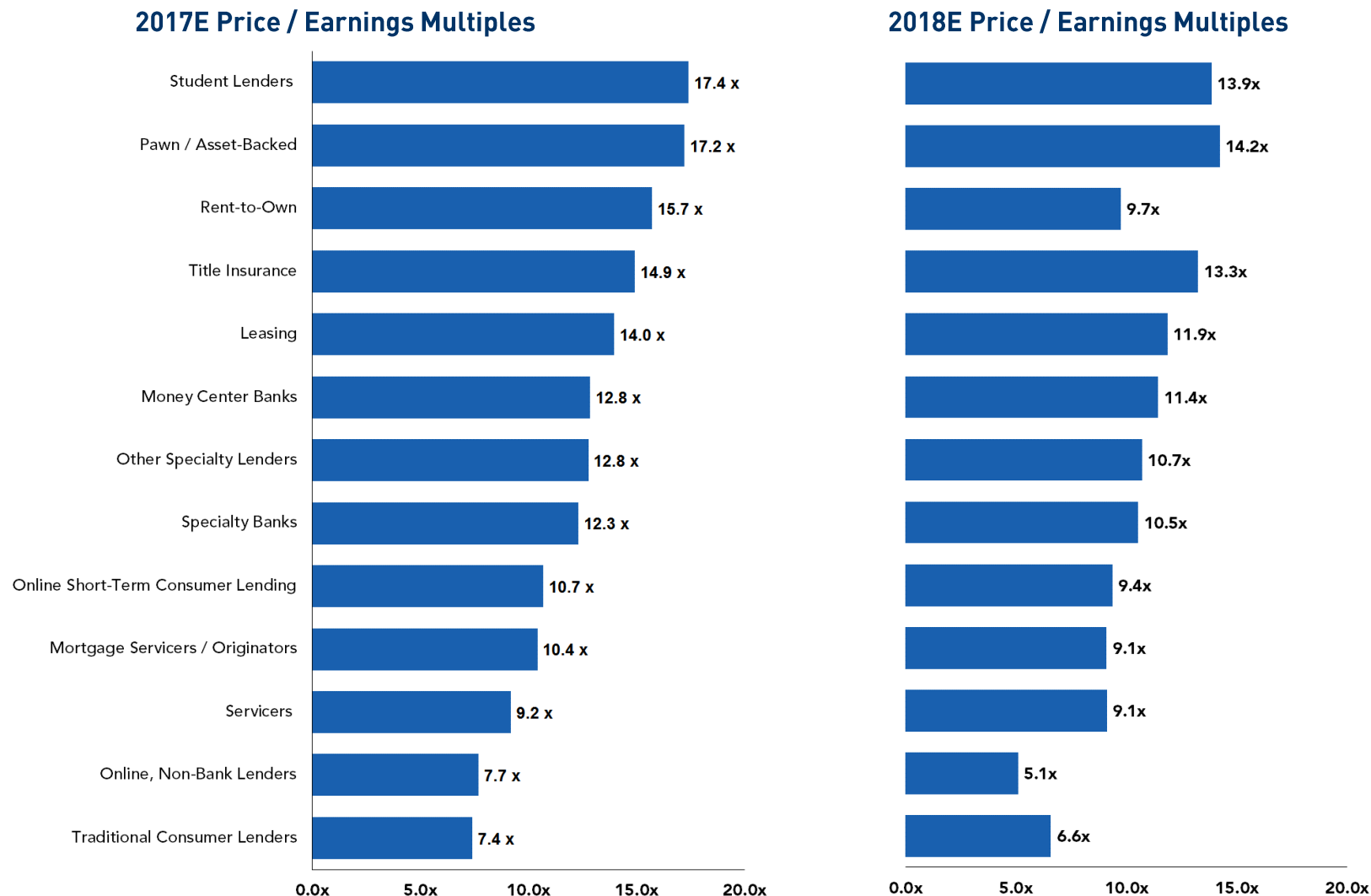
